

Loveland Public Library's Teen Advisory Board (or TAB) is for local middle + high school students who are interested in making a difference at their library. TAB members play a crucial role in:

- Planning + marketing + running teen events
- Assisting with volunteer projects in the Teen Hangout
- Creating a welcoming + safe environment for other teens at the library

TAB membership is a commitment of time.
